

Go to <http://helpdesk.lshauto.com.au/> then click on Links and you will have all the links broken down by type




## Connecting to Wi-Fi

Connect to the Ishteam network > Password is 0391332288


## Mapping Network Drive

In order to map the G Drive please follow instructions below,

1. Open Finder
2. Hit Command + K
3. Type below and hit connect  
MBM: smb://vicmbfile01/mbmdata  
MBMA: smb://vicapfile01/apdata



4. Enter your userID and password (same as eraPower) click Connect and it will appear under 'Locations' on the left


## Adding a printer

<http://bit.ly/yzsoftware>


Locate the below from the site, download and run it.
